Directions

From County Rd 27 (just west of Hwy 400) go north through Bond Head. At the next lights after Bond Head (Pete's Donuts on NE corner), turn left towards Beeton on the 8th Line. At the first set of lights in Beeton (IGA on NE corner) turn right (north) on the 10th Conc. Continue to the 11th Line and turn right (east). Take the 4th driveway on the left (#5576). Mackenzie is on the mailbox.

From the west, go east to Tottenham Rd. There is a set of lights right on the 8th Line to turn east towards Beeton (west is Loretto). Go thru the town to the lights by the IGA and turn left (north) on the 10th Conc. Continue as above.
